PE Kit



Start of the day routines

A reminder that the children are to be dropped off at the school gate from 8:30am for Juniors and 8:40am for Infants'. This will ensure that the children arrive on time and registers can be taken promptly, with lessons starting on time.

We completely understand that, occasionally, parents have messages to pass on to the class teacher and are fully supportive of this happening. This is why we always have adults placed at each entrance who will ensure that any messages are passed on to the class teacher. However, if a longer conversation is needed, then please do inform the office or arrange an appointment with the class teacher for the end of the day. I know that they are only too happy for this to happen.

On Monday 13th September we will be running our yearly 'Meet the Teacher Meetings'

This will be an opportunity for you to meet your child's class teacher and learn about the expectations of the New Year group.
