Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you and your families had an enjoyable half term break and are looking forward to the next half term. As always, it is going to be very busy and exciting – please keep 'an eye' on the school calendar for the many events planned. Already this week we have shared the Feasts of ALL Saints and All Souls and we are looking forward to the season of Advent. The gathering of many world leaders for COP26 is also very much in our minds at the moment and we continue conversations around caring for our world – as Pope Francis quite rightly calls it, our 'common home.'



On Monday 1st November, the focus of the staff training day was behaviour. It was based on the work of Paul Dix and his book 'When the adults change, everything changes'. Good behaviour is recognised sincerely rather than just rewarded. Children are praised publicly and remanded in private.

At St. Joseph's, we aim to create a safe and happy environment where exemplary behaviour enables all to feel secure and respected within an atmosphere of learning without limits. Everyone in our school is expected to maintain the highest standards of personal conduct, to accept responsibility for their behaviour and encourage others to do the same.

We recognise that each individual child is at a different stage of social learning. Only through a **consistent approach to supporting their behaviour** will we be able to achieve an environment in which children can learn and develop as caring and responsible people.

We believe that:

- Behaviour can change and every child can be successful.
- Positive, targeted praise is more likely to change behaviour than blaming and punishing.
- Reinforcing good behaviour helps children feel good about themselves.
- An effective reward system and celebrating success helps to further increase children's self-esteem enabling them to achieve even more.
- Understanding each child's needs and their individual circumstances helps us to act in the fairest way possible for that child, at that moment.

As a result from our training day we now have three simple rules: 'Be **Ready**, Be **Respectful** and Be **Safe**'. These rules have been shared with the children and the pupil leadership team alongside the school council will be leading the way.

Over the coming weeks the children will be promoting our new behaviour policy and sharing this with you. We welcome active parental involvement in order to:

- Ensure that children attend school regularly, arriving on time, alert and **ready** for the tasks ahead and are collected, promptly, at the end of the day;
- Understand and reinforce the school language as much as possible;
- Share in the concern about standards of behaviour generally;
- Support the work of the school as staff seek to support the whole family.

We will always aim to contact parents quickly when there are concerns about deteriorating levels of acceptable behaviour. Staff will also contact you to celebrate those children who are excellent role models and are following the school rules.
