It is with deep sadness that we write on behalf of the school staff and governing body to express our sincere condolences on the death of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II.

Her Majesty was an outstanding public servant who gave her life to the service of the Country and the Commonwealth. She will be remembered as a most cherished and loved Sovereign.

As a school, we came together to celebrate her 70 years of service, a historic milestone. It was a wonderful occasion and one which we will all fondly remember.

We are aware that this sad occurrence may be hard for some children to understand, and the staff will be working to support children and provide an opportunity to talk about grief and grieving.

We are awaiting guidance on whether the day of the funeral will be observed as a bank holiday and what arrangements will be in place for schools on this day.

The strong community ethos of the school is reinforced by the school uniform we ask the children to wear. Please could I reiterate school policy that shoes are expected as footwear and **not** trainers. Please do not send children in to school with rucksacks, we do not have space within the school to store them. To avoid accidents please remember that rucksacks are not allowed in school.

**Please label ALL uniform,** we have already had parents coming in looking for lost uniform. It is very difficult to help you find lost uniform which has no name in.

# Start of the day routines

A reminder that the children are to be dropped off at the school gate from 8:30am for Juniors and 8:40am for Infants'. This will ensure that the children arrive on time and registers can be taken promptly, with lessons starting on time.

We ask the Infant parents please stay with your child until the bell rings.

We completely understand that, occasionally, parents have messages to pass on to the class teacher and are fully supportive of this happening. This is why we always have adults placed at each entrance who will ensure that any messages are passed on to the class teacher. However, if a longer conversation is needed, then please do inform the office or arrange an appointment with the class teacher for the end of the day. I know that they are only too happy for this to happen.

A reminder to all parents, school starts at 8:45am for Junior children and 8:55 for Infants.
