Good morning everyone!


Let us start our worship this morning by each one of us making the sign of the cross.

We do not always understand things straight away, we need someone to teach us and to explain to us all the different things that we see in the world.


Jesus teaches his disciples in yesterday's gospel story.

What do you remember from today's reading?


The disciples were talking to each other when suddenly Jesus appeared amongst them.

Jesus explained to his friends all that it said in the Bible about him.


The disciples then understood that Jesus had risen from the dead and was the Son of God. They truly believed in him, and they were happy.
