# Welcome

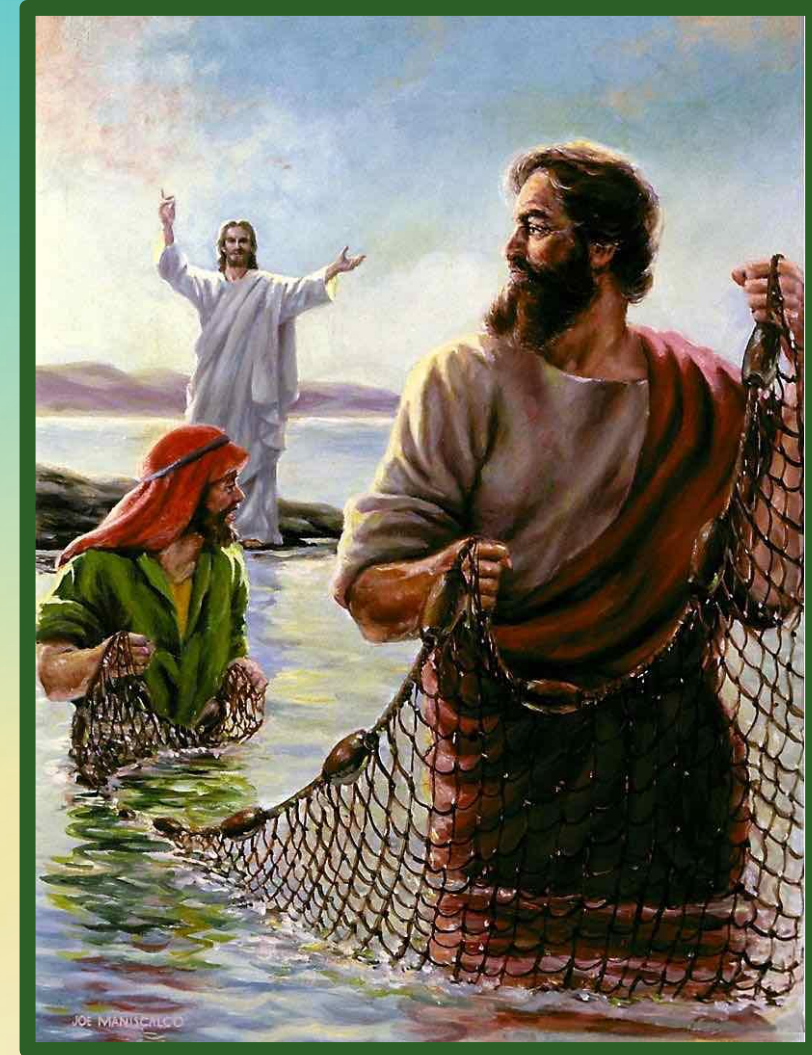
Today we hear about how Jesus called his disciples to follow him.

# MARK 1:14-20

Jesus went to a place called Galilee and preached the Good News from God. As Jesus walked along the shore of Lake Galilee, he saw two fishermen, Simon and his brother Andrew, catching fish with a net. Jesus said to them, "Come with me, and I will teach you to catch people." At once they left their nets and went with him.

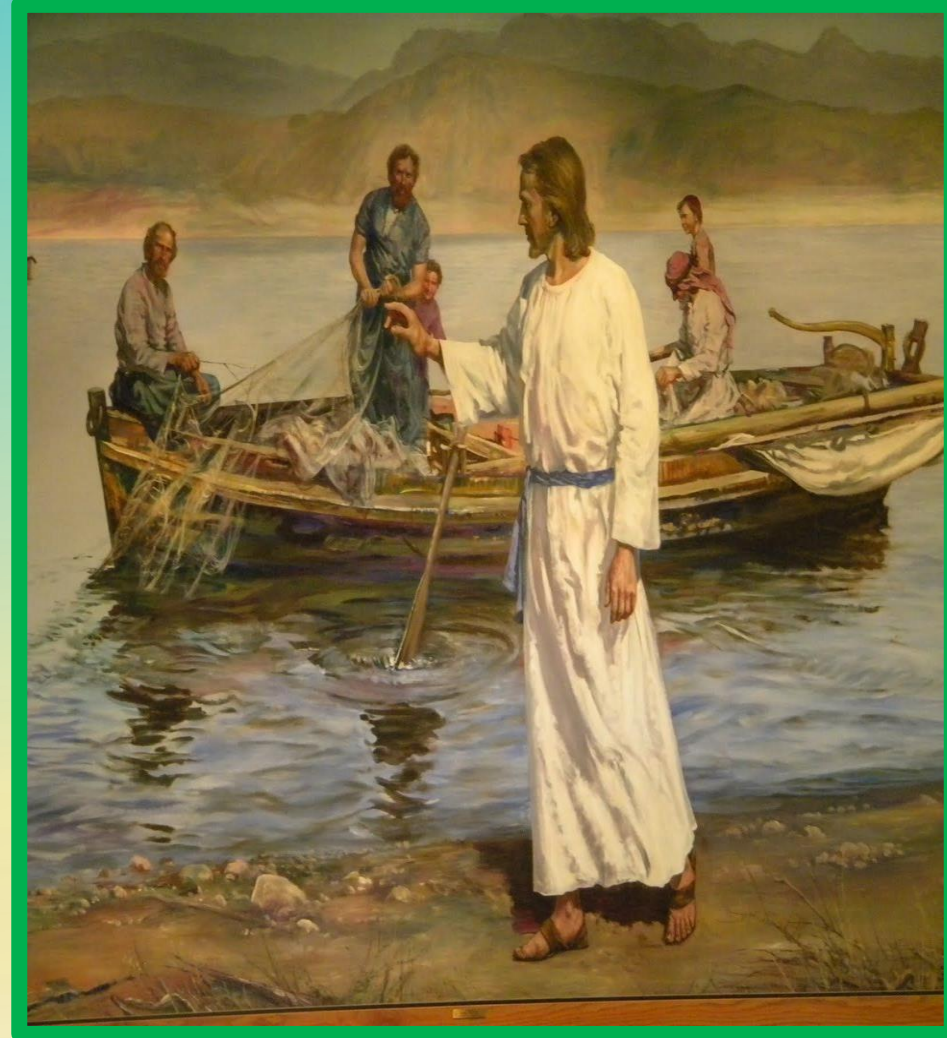


# MARK 1:14-20

He went a little further on and saw two other brothers, called James and John.

They were in their boat getting their nets ready.

As soon as Jesus saw them, he called them; they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the other men and went with Jesus





## Gospel reflection

In this passage, what is Jesus doing?

Jesus is going and telling others the good news, that he has come to save his people.

This is what it means to be a **disciple**. A **disciple** is someone who goes and tells others the good news about Jesus.

Jesus is showing us an example for how the disciples are to act in the future.

How would you feel if you had to leave your family, friends and all your things behind?



Jesus asks us all to follow him.

We cannot see Jesus now and go with him as he travels round the country but do some of the things he taught us.

Be Kind

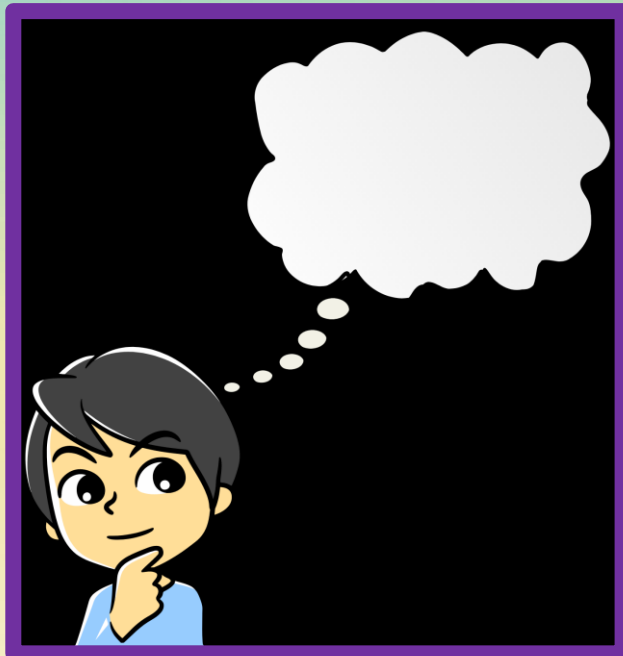
By being kind to others,
