Joshua Agho (4B) - For his enthusiasm when it comes to answering and making the most of the Spanish lesson.

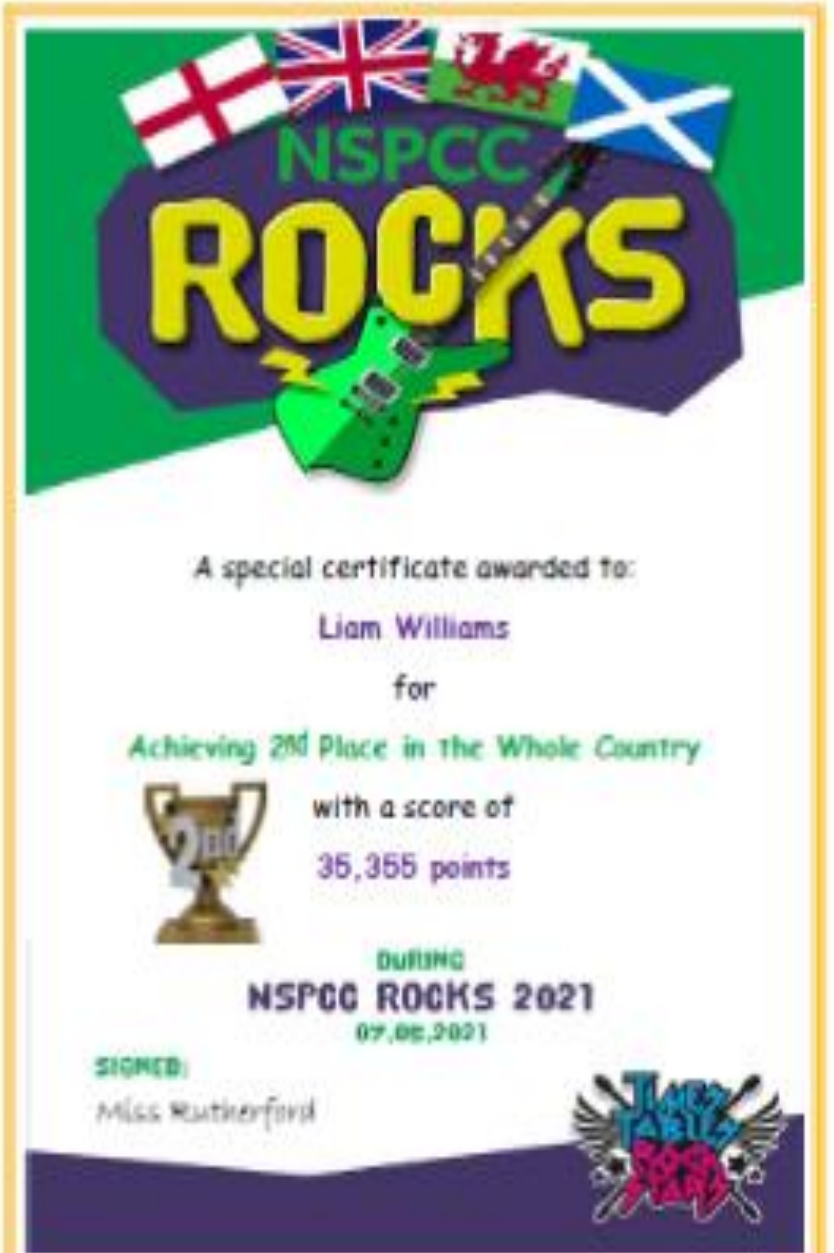
