- Fund achievement activities e.g. after-school clubs for disadvantaged pupils

- High quality work evidence within children's books, showing gaps are diminishing
- Academic achievements consistently in line with national and/or Local

Objective 2:

 To close the gap of achievement between more able pupils at St Joseph's Federation and similar pupils nationally and or Locally

Why?

- To ensure pupils achieve their full potential and that no more able pupils leaves the school underperforming
- Data shows the pace of progress for the more able has been slower than other groups
- To ensure pupils academic achievements are at least in line with both national and local achievements

How will we address this?

- Identify a More able pupil Champion who will raise the profile the more able across the Federation
- Ensure pupils are provided with high quality teaching and learning which challenges and
- Have clear and robust tracking data to identify pupils closely
- Purchase high quality resources to ensure access to all curriculum areas
- Opportunities through the curriculum for access to competitions to work alongside similar peers from other schools
- Links with stakeholders to provide opportunities for more able e.g working with local secondary schools

- Greater opportunities for working at greater depth
- Preparation for SATS working at greater depth
- Academic mentoring and intervention
- Ensure high levels of parental and pupil engagement in learning and school life, across all activities to ensure equality and fairness in access.

Outcome:

- Increase in the pace of progress
- Positive pupil engagement
- High quality work evidence within children's books, showing gaps are diminishing
- % of pupils working at greater depth across the Federation consistently in line with national and/or local expectations.

How will we address this?

- To ensure that all adults across the Federation set and expect high levels of achievement and behaviour from all BAME children
- Review the whole curriculum map in each school, this will reflect diversity and each child will be treated according to his/her uniqueness with all the attendant impact of cultural and religious background and influence
- Promote equality through whole school assemblies, RE and PSHE lessons
- High aspirations will be set for BAME children to ensure that they reach their full potential
- Inviting BAME role models into the school to talk to and encourage the children and give them first-hand experiences
- To ensure that all children are taught about the contributions that have been made by the BAME community through a range of curriculum subjects. Including the celebration of, but not limited to Black History month.
- Deliver parent workshops

- Positive pupil engagement
- Raised expectations across the Federation of BAME pupils academic potential and behaviour
- Academic achievements consistently in line with national and/or Local
- A curriculum which positively reflects the wide ranging cultures within our school
